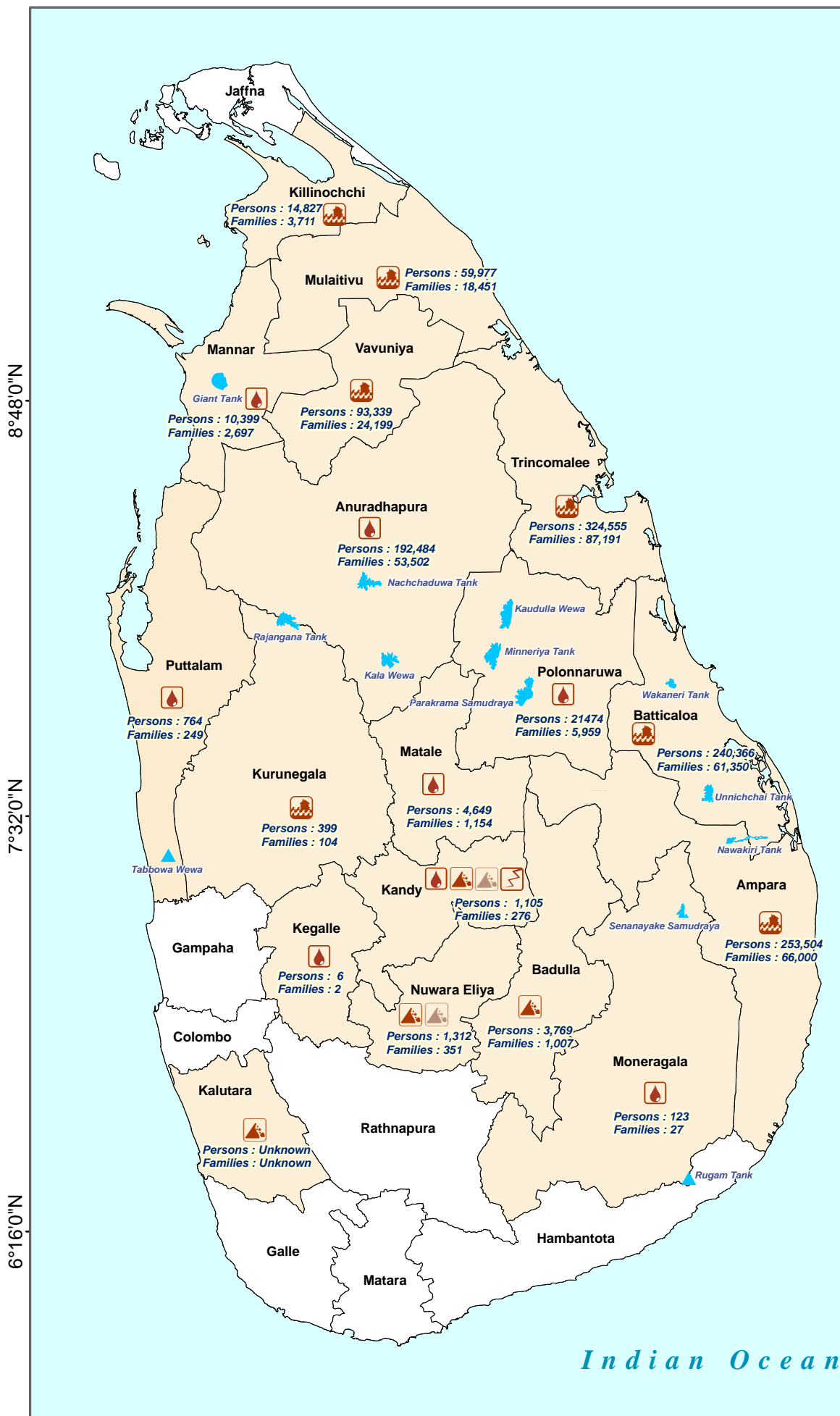


Incidents due to Heavy Rains, Floods and Landslides - Sri Lanka

Ampara	Flood	02.02.11	No Information
Anuradhapura	Heavy Rain	31.01.11	02 Sluice gate of Kalawewa, 20 sluice gates of Rajanganaya Tank, 06 sluice gates of Nachchaduwa tank opened. Handungama & Awukana bridges are inundated. Low lying areas of Galnewa, Ipalogama, Talawa, Tambuttegama, Kalaoya and Yanoya inundated. Horowpathana town was inundated. Malwatuoya Lane bridge was inundated.
Badulla	Landslide	31.01.11	Due to possibility of land slide in Mawalangala Aramaya, 30 Buddhist monks temporary evacuated to safer buddhist place. Due to possibility of land slide.
Batticaloa	Flood	03.02.11	No Information
Kandy	Heavy Rain, Landslide, Cutting Failure, Fallen Tree and Possibility of more landslides	01.02.11, 04-05.02.11	Affected family evacuated to Deiyannawela School. One death and a injured person reported due to a fallen tree.
Kalutara	Cutting Failure	03.02.11	No Information
Kegalle	Heavy Rain	03.02.11	Affected family lives with their relative.
Kilinochchi	Flood	04.02.11, 06.02.11	No Information
Kurunegala	Flood	04.02.11, 05.02.11	No Information
Mannar	Heavy Rain	05.02.11	No Information
Matale	Heavy Rain	31.01.11	Landslide in Puchi Rattota GN Division is continued & monitoring the site.
Monaragala	Heavy Rain	03.02.11	Dunume wewa dam is to be breaching. 06 sluice gates of Senanayake Samudraya opened.
Mullaitivu	Flood	04.02.11	No Information
Nuwara Eliya	Landslide & Possibility of more landslides	01.02.11, 04.02.11	Land slide occurred in Kandapola aluthpara junction. Road impassable. Kahandapola area in Nuwaraeliya - Ragala road inundated and impassable due to flood.
Polonnaruwa	Heavy Rain	31.01.11	All sluice gates of Parakrama Samudraya were closed, 11 sluice gates of Kawudulla and 07 sluice gates of Minneriya tank opened, Polonnaruwa - Batticaloa road opened.
Puttalam	Heavy Rain	03.02.11, 04.02.11	17 sluice gates of Rajanganaya, 08 sluice gates of Tabbowa & 06 sluice Inginiyitiya tanks opened. Anamaduwa - Nawagattegama road inundated and impassable.
Trincomalee	Flood	31.01.11	Some low-lying areas and some roads inundated due to over flowing of irrigation tanks.
Vavuniya	Flood	31.01.11, 05.02.11	A child drowned due to drowning.
