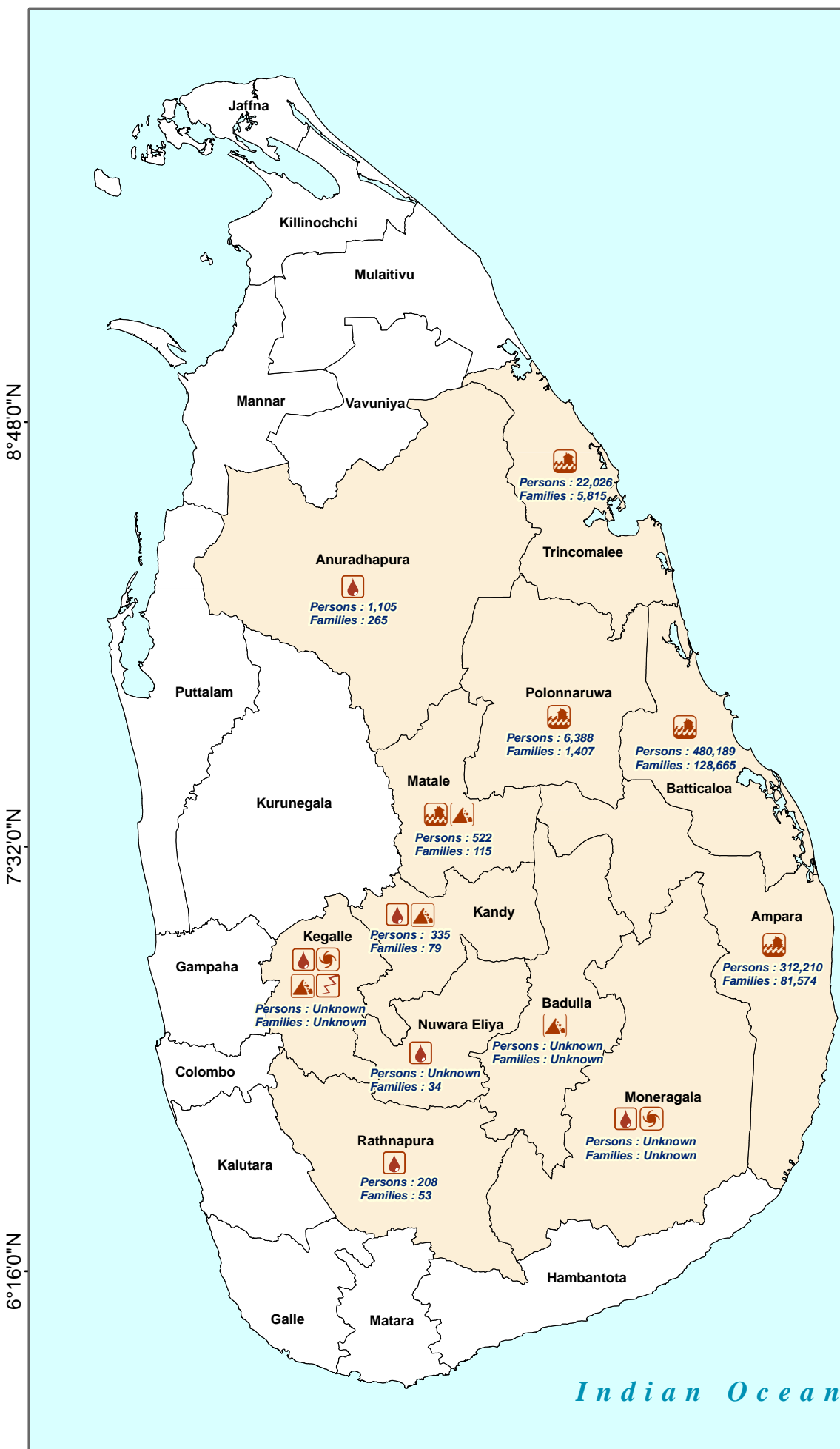


# Incidents due to Heavy Rains, Floods and Landslides - Sri Lanka

Summary of Incidents between 06 - 10 January 2011

Ampara	Flood	06.01.2010	No Information
Anuradhapura	Heavy Rain	09.01.2010	Horowpathana town inundated & some roads Impassable due to over flowing of Dematawewa. Tikkampatana dam has breached. 72 houses inundated. 002 sluice gate of Kalawewa, 10 sluice gates of Rajanganaya tank and 02 sluice gates of Padawiya tank opened.
Badulla	Earth Slip	09.01.2010	No Information
Batticaloa	Flood	09.01.2011	No Information
Kandy	Heavy Rain & Landslide	09.01.2011	Ampitiya - Talatuoya road, Bahirawa kanda Vihara road, Mahanuwara - Mahiyanganaya road (close to Wewarauma), Lewella, Buwelikada, Mapanawatura, Dharmashoka Mawatha roads impassable due to earthslip. 05 houses inundated due to over flowing of Meda ela. Kalugala Road impassable.
Kegalle	Heavy Rain, High Wind, Cutting Failure & Collapse of retaining wall	09/10.01.11	No Information
Matale	Flood & Earth Slip	09.01.2011	Kandenuwara Road impassable due to earth slip.
Monaragala	Heavy Rain & High Wind	09.01.2011	8 families were evacuated to safer places. 06 sluice gates opened at Weheragala Tank.
Nuwara Eliya	Heavy Rain	09.01.2011	06 affected families evacuated to Red Cross Community Centre. Rikillagaskada - Denipe road impassable due to tree fallen & earth slip. Informed RDA for necessary action.
Polonnaruwa	Flood	09.01.2011	No Information
Ratnapura	Heavy Rain	09.01.2011	Damages due to over flowing of Konkatuwa Wewa.
Trincomalee	Flood	09.01.2011	No Information
