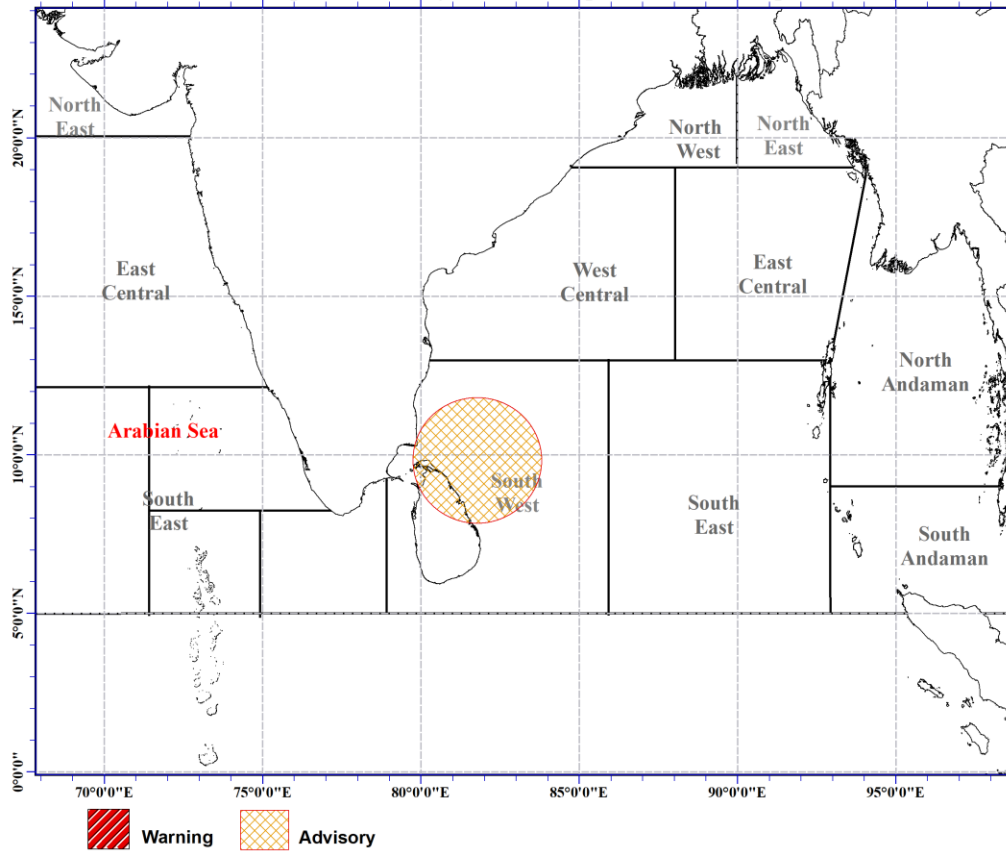

PLEASE BE AWARE!

The atmospheric disturbance that prevailed over the Bay of Bengal has developed into a low-pressure area and is currently located near 10.1N and 82.5E. Therefore, the prevailing showery conditions over the island are expected to continue.

Further, strong winds and rough seas can be expected over the deep and shallow sea areas around the island, as well as over the deep sea areas of the Bay of Bengal.
