Warning for Heavy rain, Strong winds and Rough seas



For Land area and Shallow and Deep Sea areas around Sri Lanka

PLEASE BE AWARE!

The Very Severe Cyclonic storm "AMPHAN" (pronounced as UM-PUN) further intensified into an Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm and lay centred over Central part of South Bay of Bengal and neighborhood, at 05.30 a.m. of 18th May near latitude 13.2°N and longitude 86.3°E, about 765 km North-east of Trincomalee. It is very likely intensify into a Super Cyclonic storm during next 12 hours and likely to move north-northeastwards towards west Bengal coast during the afternoon of 20th May.

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WARNINGS:

For Sea Area

- Wind speed can be increase up to (70-80) kmph at times in the sea area extending from Puttalam to Pottuvil via Galle and Hambantota.
- Wind speed reaching (100-150) kmph and gusting up to 200 kmph is prevailing over southeast and adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal.
- Under the influence of the system, heavy showers or thundershowers will occur over sea areas around the island during next 24hours.
- There is a possibility that near shore sea areas off the coast extending from Mannar to Pottuvil via Colombo, Galle and Hambanthota may experience surges due to the effect of swell waves, having (2.0-3.0) m height.
- Eastern and North-eastern deep and shallow sea areas can be high and other deep and shallow sea areas around the island will be very rough.

For Land Area

Showers or thundershowers will occur in Southern, Western, Sabaragamuwa, Central and North-western provinces with isolated very heavy showers exceeding 150 mm during next 48 hours.

The wind speed can increase up to **(60-70) kmph** at times over the island.

ACTION SUGGESTED:

For the Sea area:

- Naval and fishing communities are advised not to venture into the shallow and deep sea areas around the Island until further notice.
- Those who are out at Sea over these regions are advised to return to coasts or moved safer areas immediately.
- Requested to be attentive about future advisories issued by the Department of Meteorology in this regard.

For the Land area:

- People living in hilly areas (particularly landslide prone areas) and low lying areas in river basins are requested to be vigilant.
- Drivers and people using roads in the hilly areas are requested to be vigilant.
- Take adequate precautions to minimize damages caused by lightning activity.
- Beware of fallen trees and power lines.
- Be alert on the advisories issued by the Department of Meteorology.
- For emergency assistance contact the local disaster management authorities.
