Building the capacity of government and partners to take a Child Centred Disaster Risk Reduction (CCDRR) response that identifies, assesses and reduces the potential loss of lives, health status, livelihoods, assets and services. The Disaster Management Centre (DMC) closely works together with various non governmental organisations in keeping communities safe through initiatives, such as promotion of the Safe Schools model, community based child protection systems, raising awareness of natural and man made disasters among children using innovative technologies and youth led initiatives as well as mapping risks in schools and communities. CCDRR aims to inform and empower children at community level on risks they face and provides them with the tools to help mitigate such risks. The key objective of these programmes is adopting a long term strategy for sustainable and resilient development to ensure current and future generations can cope with climate change.
